

The following is a Grand Canyon Lottery Primer for do-it-yourself river runners seeking a permit to float the Colorado river in Grand Canyon during the 2011 rafting season. This Primer covers all the pages you will encounter to sign up for the Lottery.

Follow along as we go through the twenty or so different steps to apply. This includes info on how to set up a User Profile (That part is free). This primer provides a demo from an actual lottery application for a 2011 permit, including how to use the calendar. We also review the Profile section and the \$25 payment process. You can print this Primer out to use as you go online and step through the NPS process.

Good luck...remember, in a waiting list, at least you were assured a date unless you died waiting...and now, you may never win before you die.

1. Create and manage your user profile, which maintains your contact information, accrued points, trip history, and provides links to all pending applications you've submitted or are listed on.
2. Create a rafting permit lottery application for private (noncommercial) river trips.
3. Pay for and submit your application for consideration in the annual permit lottery.

In addition to submitting lottery applications, you may also use this website to:

- Add your email address so you will receive notifications of upcoming lotteries
- Make changes to your pending lottery application at any time up to the day of the lottery.
- Monitor the status of your pending lottery application, i.e., make sure that payment for applicable fees was successfully processed, verify that participants you listed as potential alternate trip leaders (PATLs) have confirmed their co-applicant status on your application, and double-check that there are no disqualifying problems with your lottery application.
- Find out whether or not your application was successful in the lottery.
- Access your successful application to supply additional required information and pay the remainder of the permit fees 90 days before launch. When fees are paid and permit information is complete, permits will be automatically issued and mailed.
- Easily revise unsuccessful applications and re-submit them for follow-up lotteries for cancelled or leftover permits for launches within the same year. Lottery applicants are required to pay the application fee only once per year; follow-up lotteries require no additional fee.
- Apply after the initial lottery to try and pick up a cancelled date.

Permitting process overview

The following is a quick overview of the permitting process. [A more detailed description of each step in the application and permitting process is shown here.](#)

- Step 1: Create a profile.** All persons listed on a trip permit application must have a user account in this system.
- Step 2: Login and create your application.** Once you have a profile, you can login at any time before the lottery is run to create a lottery application.
- Step 3: Submit your completed application.** The completed application will not become active until fees are paid. All PATLs listed on your application must login to this system and acknowledge their co-applicant status before the lottery drawing date. PATLs failing to do so will be automatically removed from the application.
- Step 4: Pay lottery application fee.** Pay the \$25 lottery application fee through this website.
- Step 5: Lottery occurs on designated date.** After the lottery, you will be notified of the success/failure of your lottery application by email. You can login at any time to view the status of your lottery application.
- Step 6: Completing Permit processing.** If successful in the lottery, you will be able to complete your permit application and submit final payments so that your permit can be issued.
- Step 7: Issue the permit.** When the above steps are complete, a permit will be issued.



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

Questions and Answers:

Q: What if I fail to enter my birthdate correctly?

A: Your entry must match the birthdate you created with your profile. Three consecutive failed attempts will result in your account being locked for 24 hours.

Q: Why is this step necessary?

A: This section has been added to provide an additional level of protection for your account and to eliminate the need for your date of birth information to be displayed on your main profile page.

Q: I think my birthdate is listed incorrectly in my profile, and I need my account unlocked. How can I get this fixed?

A: Please fax to the River Permit Office at 928-638-7844 a signed request to have your birthdate changed and include all the following: your legal name, date of birth, email, and current contact phone numbers. Your request will be responded to during normal business hours. If this is urgent and cannot wait due to a lottery or other deadline, please send an email with your username asking for your account to be unlocked. We will respond as soon as we can.

Q: Why is date of birth even required on this site?

A: Grand Canyon National Park's river permit system includes three important rules to ensure fairness: 1) an individual can have only one profile in the lottery system, 2) an individual can go on a maximum of one recreational river trip per calendar year, and 3) an individual will get less than 5 chances in the lottery if they have been on the river within the last 4 years. 



R2P Trip Calendar Instructions: It is a part of your application to specify the launch dates you are applying for. Our trip calendar tool allows you to do this quickly and accurately by allowing you to drag dates into the unselected calendar, what are considered as launch dates for the calendar tool. You will see launch dates available for that date only once selected by you.

You may specify that you launch dates up to five additional launch dates may be specified as well. Click on the calendar tool once on the launch date you wish to specify to open the calendar tool. You will see something similar to the example on the right. Then complete the following steps:

1. Select trip date: Click on "month" or "week" at the top of the calendar page to indicate trip date. A "week" trip allows between 1 and 7 participants, while a "month" trip allows between 7 and 10 participants. When you make this selection, the highlighted dates and number of launches for each date will change in the calendar.
2. Select trip month: Use the "+" and "-" symbols in the date grid box to select the desired month. As you click the "+" and "-" symbols, the month shown in the very top of the calendar page will change accordingly.
3. Select trip date: You will notice that some dates are highlighted, while other dates are not. You will also notice a small number in the lower right of each date box.
 - Change dates and launches within the unselected month. Selecting one of these dates gives you the option to either launch a noncommercial or non-commercial trip.
 - Follow dates are dates within the same unselected month. A trip launching on two different days may not be selected.
 - The small number in the lower right of each date box indicates the number of launches scheduled for that date. Dates which are not highlighted have no trip launches for the selected trip size and may not be selected.
4. Click on a date to select that date for your launch. The calendar tool will show you the selected date will be listed on your application as a launch date.

If you click on the wrong date or change your mind, simply click on the calendar tool again and select a different date.





lottery application period is the last opportunity you have to list a Potential Leader (PATL) for your trip. By listing at least one PATL, you will be ensuring that you will be able to continue even if something comes up and you can't make it. Historically around 10% of noncommercial river trip permittees end up not being able to go on their trips as

listed, your PATL must first have a profile on the system. To add them to your trip, you must enter their username in the PATL box above. Your PATL must then log back in under their username and confirm their co-applicant status on your trip. - Mike was on a commercial trip down the Colorado three years ago, so he has three preference points.

It's a "wait"ed lottery favoring permit holders who have not been in the last 5 years or more.

Q:

Why do you need to know the date of my last year commercial or private trip down the Colorado in order to create my profile?

A:

In order to give everyone a fair chance to experience a raft trip down the Colorado, individuals are limited to one trip (commercial or private) down the Colorado per year. Moreover, we weight the odds of winning the lottery, giving more chances to those who have not been down the river recently. Note that we do check the accuracy of "last date down the Colorado" for all applicants listed on a permit application against our historical commercial and private records before issuing each permit; false statements of "last trip" date will result in cancellation of the permit.

This prevents the permit holder from having up to date river experience. This does not apply to concessions river passengers. Don't ask us why, ask the NPS!


